TRAUMA, FEAR AND LOVE

Human development is determined by our need for love, relationship and belonging, and our desire for autonomy, self-determination and freedom. The general task deriving from this is to become autonomous in close emotional relationships. Anxieties, stress and traumatic experiences can cause serious disturbances to the psychological maturation of a person. Traumata result in the splitting of the psyche, symbiotic entanglements and many other ways of not being really autonomous.

The method of Constellations helps, by the mediation of the representatives, to reflect and show psychological conditions fairly well. It is useful to bring the unconscious and suppressed psychological realities to light and so integrate psychological splits.

This first Congress conveys the theoretical backgrounds for understanding the work with the constellations method, grounded in theories of Bonding and Trauma. The trans-generational perspective of the transfer of trauma from one generation to the next, will also be covered. The Conference offers the opportunity of witnessing the newly developed formats of the Constellation ("Constellation of trauma", and "Constellation of the Intention") in practice and its application in different fields.
